

# Cookies Policy

## 1. What are cookies and how do we use them?

Cookies are used, either by Brownie or by a third party contracted to provide metrics services, when a user browses the Website. Cookies are text files containing small amounts of information that are downloaded onto and installed on your computer or mobile device when you visit a website. The cookies are sent back to the original website during each subsequent visit, or to another website that recognises them.

## 2. Which types of cookie do we use?

Brownie uses four types of cookie:

### 2.1. Technical cookies

These cookies allow the user to browse a website, platform or application and to use the different options or services that it offers. Technical cookies include the cookies that the publisher uses to manage and run the website and to enable its features and services, for example, to monitor traffic and send data, to identify the session, to grant access to restricted areas, to record the elements of an order, to process orders, to manage payments, to monitor fraudulent activity related to the security of requests to register or attend an event, to count visits for invoicing purposes for the software licences that enable the service to operate, to use security elements during browsing, to store content so that videos and sound can be played, to enable dynamic content (for example, animated text or images) or to share content via social media.

### 2.2. Analytics cookies

These cookies enable the person responsible for setting cookies to monitor and analyse the behaviour of users on the website on which they are set, including measuring the impact of adverts. The information collected via this type of cookie is used to measure activity on a website, app or platform for the purpose of making improvements based on how users use the service.

### 2.3. Personalisation cookies

These cookies save information so that the user can access the service with characteristics that may make their experience different to that of other users, for example, language, number of results to display when the user performs a search, appearance or content of the service depending on the type of browser through which the service is accessed, regional settings based on where the service is accessed from, etc.

### 2.4. Advertising cookies

These cookies store information about users' behaviour that is obtained by constantly observing their browsing habits, which can be used to create a specific profile to show tailored adverts.

#### 4. How can you uninstall cookies?
